



## 2006-2007 (Rite of Confirmation) Service Guidelines

LIST THE EVENT, DATE, AND EXPLAIN IN A BRIEF STATEMENT WHAT YOU GAINED FROM YOUR PARTICIPATION IN EACH OF THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES.

Remember that all events are to take place during the 2006-2007 school year.

It is recommended that you refer to this periodically and complete it throughout the year.

**YOUTH MINISTRY SERVICE ACTIVITIES:** Examples include Servants in Christ, Nursing Home Projects, monthly Confirmation projects, etc.

**LIFE NIGHTS:** Make sure you are a part of these nights that truly bring the Word to life!!!

**“SOUPER BOWL” WEEKEND:** You and your peers will participate in the Souper Bowl of Caring Collection at the Feb. 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> weekend Masses collecting funds for local ministries of your choice.

**SPIRITUAL:** Examples include The Call Retreat, Servants in Christ, J-Fest Retreat, Destination Jesus Retreat, Youth Band, Living Stations, or regular attendance at LIFE Nights.

**LEADERSHIP:** Examples include serving on a retreat team, other than your ROC Retreat, Middle School EDGE and/or High School LIFE Night Core Teams, J-Night planning team, Youth Council, or planning a Youth Ministry event.

**COMMUNITY:** Participate in a project that improves your community, such as a trash pick-up, spend a day at Saint Vincent DePaul, a food pantry, etc.

**SPONSOR INVOLVMENT:** Spend some quality time with your sponsor participating in a joint service project, discussing your Confirmation Questions, etc. Tell us about one of your interactions, other than the Day Retreat.

**PERSONAL:** Spend more time in individual prayer such as attending daily mass, reading more scripture, praying the rosary, etc.

Have fun and remember we are all supposed to be the hands and feet of Christ.

Return upon its' completion, but no later than March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2007.
